1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 WIPO

The World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) is the global forum for intellectual property services, policy, information and cooperation. It is a self-funding agency of the United Nations, with 189 member states.

WIPO's mission is to lead the development of a balanced and effective international intellectual property (IP) system that enables innovation and creativity for the benefit of all. Its mandate, governing bodies and procedures are set out in the WIPO Convention, which established WIPO in 1967.

1.2 Background (e-Tutorial)

In November 2012, WIPO launched an interactive e-tutorial on using and exploiting patent information designed as a training tool and reference work for individuals across various levels of competency in the field of information. It is intended to complement on-site and distance training provided by WIPO among other things within the framework of the Technology and Innovation Support Center (TISC) program.

The e-tutorial comprises 3 sections on: Patent Basics, Patent Search and Retrieval, and on Patent Analysis. Each section contains a number of interactive tutorials explaining how to use and exploit patent information followed by a number of scenarios providing story-based exercises putting theory into practice.

The e-tutorial is available online on WIPO's web pages and on CD-ROM. the English version of the e-tutorial can be accessed at <u>http://www.wipo.int/tisc/en/etutorial/main.html</u>.

1.3 Current Status

The e-tutorial is available in English, French Spanish and Russian languages at present. It is expected that an Arabic language version will be prepared to serve the needs of Arabic speaking member states of WIPO.

The e-tutorial is currently available in Adobe Flash format, a legacy format requiring installation of additional browser plugins that is expected to be phased out in the coming years. Moreover, it is not possible to produce the e-tutorial in Arabic in Adobe Flash since it does not support text written from right to left.

1.4 Objectives

The purpose of this request for information is to identify companies that would:

- replicate the e-tutorial in HTML5 format for the English, French, Spanish, and Russian versions;
- prepare translation tables with all text in the English version of the e-tutorial (including still and motion graphics);
- input the translated text in Arabic language (to be provided by WIPO) into the replicated e-tutorial in HTML5 format (including into still and motion graphics);
- replace selected graphics with appropriate Arabic language versions as required (e.g. screenshots of patent databases and patent documents, to be provided by WIPO).

 - HTML5 format;
 - Compliant with W3C recommendations in particular WCAG 2.0 (accessibility);
 - Compatible with Moodle 2.8 and newer;
 - Compatible with Firefox 44 and newer, Chrome 48 and newer, Safari 9 and newer;
 - Supports Latin character sets (English, French, German, Portuguese, Spanish) and non-Latin character sets (Arabic, simplified Chinese, traditional Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Russian).
